Drs. Dr. Femino, director of both the Division of Orthopedic Surgery and the Joint and Spine Institute at Clara Maass Medical Center, has

performed thousands of hip and knee replacements and often does them as an outpatient procedure. He uses minimally invasive techniques, which reduce pain and speed recovery. Dr. Ducey, who specializes in sports medicine, performs arthroscopic procedures on knees, shoulders, and hips, as well as anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction and both anatomic and reverse shoulder replacements. Dr. Queler, who specializes in foot and ankle surgery, including ankle arthroscopies and total ankle replacements, also corrects deformities such as flat feet and painful bunions, and has performed many limb-saving surgeries.
